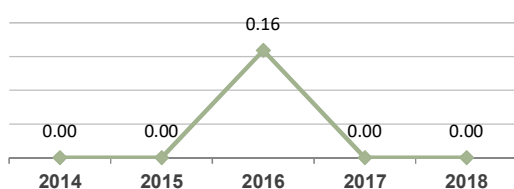

### The most problematic factors for exporting to Chad \*

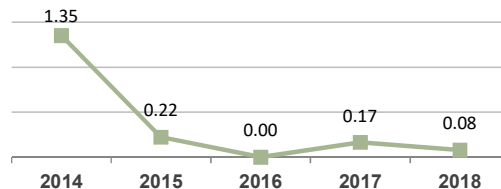
- 1 Corruption at the border
