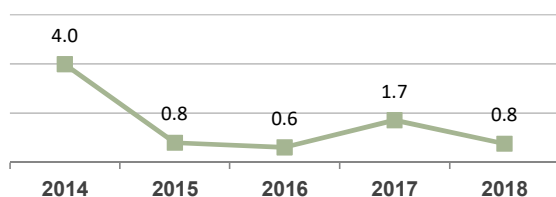

Israel's Goods Trade Relations with Haiti

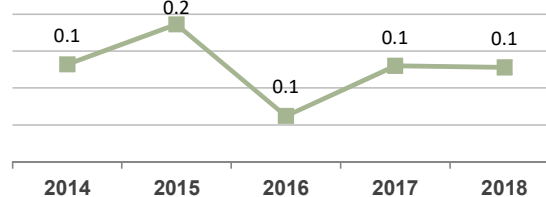
