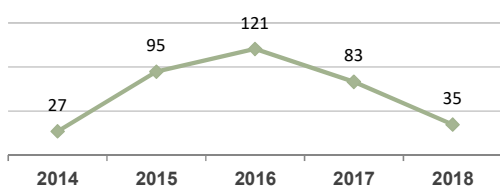
The most problematic factors for exporting to Indonesia *

- 5 Burdensome import procedures

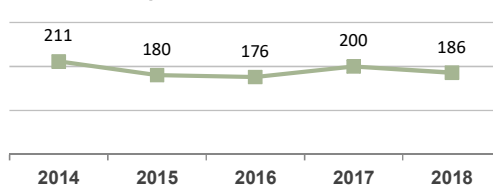
